MP SPEARHEADS EFFORT: £5.2B FLOOD DEFENCE PLAN WITH £190M FOR SEVERN VALLEY

The Chancellor pledged £5.2 billion for flood defences by 2027, allocating £190 million to the Severn Valley. Additionally, a £1.5 million trial is set for regional flood planning. He advocates for innovative water management strategies in partnership with the Environment Agency and supports integrating an Environmental Innovation Zone into the Water Management Scheme.



ROYAL SHREWSBURY HOSPITAL UPGRADE APPROVED: A NEW ERA OF HEALTHCARE IN SHROPSHIRE

Plans to improve hospital care for all our communities in Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin and Mid-Wales have taken a significant step forward, with full planning permission granted for the Royal Shrewsbury Hospital development. This follows the welcome news of the formal approval of the Outline Business Case and official contractor announcement which will enable the transformation of hospital services across the communities it serves.



NEXT-GEN TRAVEL: SHREWSBURY GEARS UP FOR GREENER, FASTER RAIL WITH ENHANCED SERVICES.

Significant enhancements are happening on the Shrewsbury-Wolverhampton line, including electrification for faster, greener travel. New eco-friendly trains are on the Birmingham-Shrewsbury and Shrewsbury-London routes. From June 2024, there will be extra hourly services between Shrewsbury and Birmingham, marking progress in sustainable rail.





REVIVING SHREWSBURY: £18.7M FOR TOWN CENTRE MAKEOVER BEGINS

The proposed demolition of the Riverside centre - and approved demolition of the former Riverside Medical Practice – is the first stage in our Smithfield Riverside regeneration project.

This will pave the way for key enabling works, clearing the site, and creating a landmark new public park adjacent to Roushill, helping to reinvigorate the area. Work will be funded by £19 million of Govt Levelling Up money.

"Exactly one year ago, I helped secure £18.7 million from the Conservative Government by lobbying them to award Shropshire Council with the money from the Levelling Up Fund to redevelop Shrewsbury's town centre.

The town centre is the heart of Shrewsbury and the redevelopment of the Smithfield and Riverside areas means that it will continue to beat for the foreseeable future.

I am of course thrilled to read the Council's recent announcement that the old Riverside Shopping Centre is going to close soon for demolition which will pave the way for work to commence on building our new regenerated town centre.

Well done to everyone at the Council, especially Professor Mark Barrow, who has worked so hard to start making this vision a reality!"
